

Starlight styling stripes - dark blue/gold now available - 12/04/2005

We have been running for some time the grey/blue styling stripes for Starlights built from 1991 upto about 1994. This comprises the blue/grey cavita tape and also the wider blue/grey band for the coachroof. Also available are the shaped fore and aft logos.

We have now been able to source the dark blue/gold tape as fitted by Bowman from about 1995 to the most recent boats.

All the above tape is sold in 10m rolls (sufficient to do one side) and both coloured tapes are secured in position by a backing tape which maintains a constant gap. We also supply comprehensive instructions on how to remove the old tape and fit the new and also how to do patching as a result of fender rub.

It is worth mentioning that from about 1989, Sadler International discontinued the red/blue styling stripe and put the grey/blue stripe on all Sadlers as well. We have now done several boats using the grey/blue tape and of course can then fit the coachroof tape which certainly looks very stylish and reduces apparent height of the coachroof.

As far as price is concerned, we have managed to make a small reduction and up-to-date prices are shown in the Equipment list by clicking the Equipment button. Currently all tape is £24 per 10m roll + vat and a set of 4 logos is £24. The coachroof tape is slightly more expensive at £28 per 10m roll.
